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### Questions With And Without Auxiliaries

However, question words can replace either an object or a subject in sentences – and when this happens, questions may be formed without inverting the verb or adding an auxiliary verb. If that sounds complicated, here's some examples to explain.

### Grammar: questions without auxiliaries: Exercise 4

The first question is a normal question and uses the form which we almost always use for a question: question word + auxiliary + subject + verb In the second question, the question word is the subject. When the question word is the subject there is no auxiliary verb and the verb agrees with the subject.

Sentences without BE and without Auxiliary Verbs. For simple questions with an auxiliary verb before the main verb, there are three possible answers: with Yes, with No, and with I don't know. The answers with Yes and No can be complete sentences or "abbreviated forms." In the "abbreviated forms," the auxiliary verb is do, does, or did. Examples:
